Introduction

Education is one of the most powerful tool to bring one out of ignorance and darkness. Education can also improve the standard of our society. With this main aim, **Selvi Kandaraj Educational & Charitable Trust** was formed on **24th September 2007**. The goal of the trust is to help underprivileged Indian children in their education by providing them social and financial support. Our trust mostly helps children studying in government schools and colleges with an emphasis on the rural poor. To date, we have provided support to over 3,700 students from all over Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry.

This report provides a comprehensive overview of our activities, financial status, and major developments over the past year. It highlights our efforts to support our students, details of trustees, and significant milestones achieved. This year has been pivotal for our organization as we have not only expanded our reach but also significantly enhanced our capacity to serve our community.

About Us

We started in 2007 in a small way. Enthused by the vision of helping the helpless and empowering them, a small group of friends based in Chennai came together and started to help poor students by providing them educational kits. We then began to provide educational support to the orphan inmates of "Love Foundation" in Minjur. Gradually, as news about our work spread, people started to reach out to us to offer help as well as receive our help! Our scope and area of operations gradually widened. Today, we are helping students of government schools and colleges in places like Chennai, Pondicherry, Kanchipuram, Mayiladuthurai, Erode, Salem, and Nagercoil.

Our Programs:

Our two flagship programs, "Kalvi Karuvi" and "Kalluri Kalvi Udhavu Thogai," provide muchneeded educational and financial support to the rural students of our state. We have now obtained eligibility for Income Tax Exemption from the IT Department, are eligible to receive CSR grants from companies, and can also accept foreign donations.

Under the "Kalvi Karuvi" program, we provide students with educational kits worth around Rs 2,000/- per student. To date, we have supported around 3,500 students and distributed kits. This financial year we helped 250 Students in this category.

Under the "Kalluri Kalvi Udhavu Thogai" program, this year we supported around 35 students to pursue their higher education in government colleges by paying their fees. These students are pursuing degree courses in Arts, Commerce, Science, Engineering, Law and Medicine. This financial year we helped 42 such students in this category. We are proud to say that last year, one of our students successfully completed her medical degree course and has been posted as an Assistant Surgeon in a government hospital at Sivakasi. We also provide laptops and computers to deserving students wherever feasible.

We are also running an "Evening Tuition Centre" at Michaelpalayam in Erode district. To help our students gain confidence, we organize English-speaking as well as motivational classes both online and offline. We also support the inmates of "Resource Centre" in Nagercoil.

During the period from 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024, a total of 12 trustee meetings were held. These meetings were essential for strategic planning, reviewing, and making critical decisions on trust activities to drive the NGO forward. Key discussions included student selection, educational kit procurement and distribution, financial status, policy updates, etc.

Major Developments

- Receiving FCRA Certificate: We are pleased to announce that we received the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act (FCRA) certificate this year. This significant milestone will enable us to receive foreign donations, enhancing our ability to fund our programs and extend our reach. The FCRA certification opens new avenues for partnerships with international organizations and donors, allowing us to scale up our impact.
- Receiving CSR Certificate: In addition to the FCRA certificate, we are delighted to announce that our Trust has received the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) certificate this year. This certification is a testament to our commitment to ethical practices and social responsibility. With the CSR certificate, we can now forge stronger partnerships with corporate entities, enabling us to tap into a broader pool of resources and expertise. This development significantly enhances our ability to fund our initiatives, expand our programs, and make a greater impact in the communities we serve. The certification also reinforces



our credibility and accountability, ensuring our donors and partners that their contributions are being utilized effectively for social good.

Classes Conducted

- Motivational Classes: These sessions aim to inspire and motivate our students to pursue their goals. Topics covered included self-confidence, goal setting, and resilience. Expert speakers and successful alumni were invited to share their experiences and insights.
- English Speaking Classes: Conducted to improve the communication skills of our students. The classes focused on grammar, vocabulary, and conversational skills. Participants showed significant improvement in their ability to communicate effectively in English, which is crucial for their academic and professional growth.

Computers and Laptops

This year, we provided a total of 3 computers and 5 laptops to various educational centers and students to enhance their learning experience. These devices were distributed to coordinators, evening tuition centers, and individual students who showed exceptional academic performance. Access to technology has significantly improved their ability to learn and perform well in their studies.

Evening Tuition Center

We supported an evening tuition center in Erode by providing educational assistance to over 30 students. This center offers additional support to students struggling with their studies, helping them improve their academic performance. Trained tutors conduct classes in various subjects, ensuring that each student receives the attention they need.
